Growing Together Toward Excellence

J.E. Prass Building "I Will" Statements:

1. I will treat myself and others with respect.
2. I will behave in a responsible way.
3. I will make good choices.

Classroom "I Will" Statements:

1. I will take turns listening and speaking
2. I will follow directions the first time they are given.
3. I will keep all objects, hands and feet to myself.

Rewards:

Verbal praise, privileges, stickers, read-ins, Treasure Box trips, class movie

Consequences:

Green: all is well (all students start every day on "green")

Yellow: verbal warning

Red: note home and a brief time-out in the classroom

Blue: principal's office and phone call home

*Individual and class rewards/consequences may be changed as the year progresses and students know the expectations for classroom behavior. This may also be altered on an individual basis, as needed.

*Second grade has two recesses: one mandated at lunch and another at the teacher's discretion (either morning or afternoon). Any homework not completed will be made up during the extra recess time.
